Directions to Connie & Ule's: Get off on Stevenson Drive from I-55. Take a left, pass the power plant. Weave around Lake Springfield, passing several parks, a golf course, the Henson Robinson Zoo. Pass the Zoo, take a left on Honeywell Road, a few streets down at the end of the road, make a right onto Ramsey Road. Ramsey makes a hard turn to the left and changes to Sage Road. Pass the trailer. We are the solar paneled house with the fence in front, just past the trailer.

COVID Safety Plan

- Do not attend if you have a fever, any illness symptoms, or have been in contact with anyone suspected of having COVID.
- We will be practicing social distancing of at least 6 feet, except for members of the same household.
- You will be expected to wear a face mask any time you might be within 6 feet of another person.
- Food and beverages will not be provided, other than bottled water. Please bring your own refreshments.
- Masks must be worn when entering Connie and Ule's home to use the facilities.

Inspection

- Masks will be worn by inspection committee and handler of dog.
- Handler will be asked to show dog's bite.
- Handler will be asked to wipe bitches and show the inspection committee the tissue.

Boxing

- The box operator and participants will wear masks as the dogs are loaded.

Catching

- Wear a mask to catch your dog.

Line Judging

- A single line judge will be positioned on the line on each side of the track.
- We will use electronic devices to act as the second and/or third judges.

Conformation

- Both the judge and handlers will wear masks.
- The judge will use hand sanitizer between touching dogs.

Awards

- Trophies will be placed on a table and participants will be called up one at a time to take a price.

Anyone not following the above rules will be asked to leave with no refunds for entries.
