## **CAMPING & PARK ENTRANCE FEE INFORMATION**

(the information below is for camping at the field with no hookups Campsites with hookups are available in the camping areas elsewhere in the park)

**Vehicle Permits Required** – *If the vehicle is NOT already displaying an annual vehicle permit on their lower left hand front window, then upon arriving each vehicle MUST stop and purchase a daily permit. You may stop at the Pay Booth at the entrance of the State Park, or right past it to the Self-pay Station located across the street from the Park Office.*

*Daily vehicle permits (\$5.00/each). The permit is valid from time of purchase until 2 pm the following day.*

*Annual vehicle permits are available as well. \$25.00/Valid for the rest of the year and are valid at all Kansas State Parks.*

**If the Self-pay station is used-** *After completing the information on the envelope and enclosing fees, please retain the back sticker portion from the envelope and display on the lower left, driver's side of your windshield as your receipt & vehicle permit. Each vehicle will need to complete a self-pay envelope. You may add your camping fees to the same self pay envelope. Deposit the envelope with payment into the metal payment slot, located in the middle of the selfpay station with the words Self Pay below the slot.*

**Primitive Camping Fees** – *anyone who camps overnight must pay the overnight camping fees. \$10.00/per camping unit plus a processing fee of \$3.00 per transaction. You may pay with the Campground #1 Host or complete a Self Pay envelope and deposit your fees at the Self Pay Station. (**Camping Unit = vehicle, tent, camper etc.. FYI - Example...** If you have friends and you all are sleeping in your camper van etc. that's only one camping fee and one processing fee for the van that you are all sleeping in. The other vehicles will only have to have the vehicle permit. If each of you use a tent then that's a per tent charge. You have a tent attached to the back of your vehicle? That's a camping fee and vehicle fee.)*

**Restrooms** – *animals are not allowed in public restroom buildings.*

## **DIRECTIONS**

### **From the Kansas City Area**

I-35 to I-435

West on Highway 10 to Lawrence. Exit on Clinton State Parkway and turn left. Turn right at the stop sign at the end of Clinton State Parkway. Clinton State Park will be the second road on your left (1415 Rd) just before the RV storage. Follow the signs for HCA Coursing.

### **For I-70 Drivers**

Take I-70 (East from Topeka, West from Kansas City), exit at Lecompton (Hwy 10) and turn South. Exit at Clinton Parkway and turn right. Turn Right again at the dead end. Clinton State Park will be the second road on your left (1415 Rd) just before the RV storage.

## PROCEDURES FOR COVID-19 SAFETY

We will follow State of Kansas and Douglas County guidelines.

Bring your own facial covering. All participants will be required to wear facial coverings when not in their cars.

Bring your own poop bags and please pick up after your dogs. This is a State Park and we would like to continue using this facility.

Bring your own pens and paper to avoid having to borrow from others.
