Dogs must be box trained before being allowed to enter. This is for the safety of the dog and for the dogs running with them.***

Park Rules:

The Park at Briar Chapel has several rules we must follow:

1. Park hours 8am to 6pm (gates close and lock when not open).
2. **No Parking on grass** - you must stay in the paved parking lot - it is right next to the race track
3. **Motorhomes will be limited to a maximum of 4 total** (only 2 can be over 40 feet long). - these 4 spots will be available first come first serve so reserve your spot early.
4. No golf carts allowed on track/grass areas. No Pop-up tents unless approved.
5. **No Parking/camping overnight** - this includes Motorhomes
6. Dogs must remain on a leash at ALL times except when RACING - no exceptions!!
7. Clean up after your dogs as Always! :)

DIRECTIONS:

The Park at Briar Chapel - 1015 Andrews Store Road, Pittsboro, NC 27312

From the North:

-- travel south on I-95 and using the right 2 lanes and take exit 51 for I-85 S/US-460 W towards Durham/Atlanta. Continue on I-85 south for 128 miles, entering into NC. Keep right at the fork to continue on US-15 S/US-501 S, follow signs for US-70 BUS/ Hillsborough Rd/Chapel Hill. Keep right to stay on US-15 S/US-501 S and take the US-15 S/US-501 S/NC-86 N exit towards Chapel Hill/Pittsboro. Use the left 2 lanes to turn left onto NC-86 S/US-15 S/US-501 S/S Columbia St/US Hwy 15 501 N and continue to follow US-15 S/US-501 S. In 6.8 miles turn right onto Andrews Store Rd. In 1 mile the park will be on your left - 1015 Andrews Store Rd - The Park at Briar Chapel. Enter the park and follow the driveway to the LEFT. There will be a parking lot near a bath house. This is our designated parking area. NO PARKING on the GRASS! All vehicles must stay in the parking lot.

From the South:

-- travel north on I-85; Keep left at the fork to stay on I-85 N, follow signs for Route 85 N/US-421 S/I-40 E/Durham/Sanford/I-73 N/ US-421 N/I-40 W/Winston-Salem. Take Exit 126A-126B to merge onto US-421 S toward Sanford. Take Exit 171 for US-64 toward Siler City/Pittsboro and turn Left onto US-64 E. Continue for 15.3 miles and take Exit 383 for US-15 N/US-501 N/Chapel Hill Rd. Drive 6.6 miles and turn left onto Andrews Store Rd. In 1 mile the park will be on your left - 1015 Andrews Store Rd - The Park at Briar Chapel. Enter the park and follow the driveway to the LEFT. There will be a parking lot near a bath house. This is our designated parking area. NO PARKING on the GRASS! All vehicles must stay in the parking lot.

From the West:

- travel east on I-40; Keep left at the fork to stay on US-421 S and follow signs for I-73 s/I-85/Ashboro. Merge onto I-73/US-421 S and continue on US-421 S (signs for I-85 N/I-40 E/Durham/Raleigh). Merge onto I-85 N/US-421 S and in 3.8 miles take Exit 126A-126B to merge onto US-421 S toward Sanford. Take Exit 171 for US-64 toward Siler City/Pittsboro and turn Left onto US-64 E. Continue for 15.3 miles and take Exit 383 for US-15 N/US-501 N/Chapel Hill Rd. Drive 6.6 miles and turn left onto Andrews Store Rd. In 1 mile the park will be on your left - 1015 Andrews Store Rd - The Park at Briar Chapel. Enter the park and follow the driveway to the LEFT. There will be a parking lot near a bath house. This is our designated parking area. NO PARKING on the GRASS! All vehicles must stay in the parking lot.

TRAC 2020

NEW COVID-19 Rules to help make this event safe!!!

1. To hold a meet we must have approval by the NC State and County Park system to hold the event. At this time (September 2020) the State of NC is allowing gatherings but are limited to outdoor gatherings to 50 people or less. All TRAC club members and all exhibitors will follow the **State** and **Local** guidelines.
2. Currently NC law requires masks when out in public. We will **require** wearing masks at this event (Specifically but not limited to: at or around the board, boxing dogs, catching dog, and judging at the line). If you are in your vehicle, you can have your mask off, but please have it on hand so you can easily put it on. **If you are not willing to wear a mask please DO NOT ATTEND.**
3. We will require everyone to practice social distancing consistent with current guidelines when ever possible. Avoid congregating to the extent possible. Avoid shaking hands or hugging.
 - a - in our opinion, there are several aspects to CWA racing where keeping a distance of 6 feet are unavoidable.
 1. Wicketing, 2. Boxing, 3. Catching, 4. Judging dogs at the finish line and 5. during the Match
 - b - in order to hold a meet, as a club we must feel comfortable that in these situations, despite trying, complete social distancing will be impossible and if this is not acceptable a meet should not be held. You must wear a mask during these times.
 - c - with inspection, we would ask that only one person bring the dog to the inspection line.
 - we would ask the owner to show their dogs own bite AND wipe their own bitches under our supervision.
4. We will have some hand sanitizer available for everyone to use. Please bring your own to use when possible.
5. We will require all entries to PRE-ENTER and use PayPal for payment if at all possible- this will avoid handling of paper as much as possible. (this will include practices at this time).
6. We will ask that each person look at the "Board" one at a time, if possible, take a quick photo and move on so the next person can look at the results and new draw.
 - 6.b - We will mark a space around the secretaries table and ask that everyone besides the Meet Secretary stay out.
7. We will not provide any food, neither for breakfast or lunch. We ask that each individual BYO food for the day.
8. We would ask that each person come with their own equipment (muzzles, jackets and Leads).

9. To help protect our Club, we will require that all participants sign a "COVID 19" release form (attached below) prior to attending the event.

This will be provided online, as well as having some available paper copies at the event as a back up. It is also include at the END of this Flyer!

10. Anyone not keeping up with the above rules will be asked to leave, NO MONEYS RETURNED.

TRAC COVID-19 Release Form - (include one for Each Person attending)

I understand that TRAC, as a club, is attempting to provide a safe yet fun event in the times of COVID-19 and agree to the following rules to attend:

- * TRAC is asking everyone that attends to be responsible and be respectful of the whole group and act in a manner that is consistent with social distancing to help prevent the spread of COVID-19; this includes but is not limited to wearing a mask (this is a North Carolina Law) and keeping a distance of 6 feet from each other when possible.

I understand that if I do not comply with the above rules I will be asked to leave and will NOT receive a refund.
