

PROPOSED REVISION TO CWA RULES FOR EVENTS

As stated in Chapter 1, Paragraph B. 8: "The Rules Committee shall be comprised of the Board of Directors. Drafts of proposed rule changes must be submitted to the Secretary by October 1. No proposals submitted after October 1 can be voted on. The Secretary shall post all drafts for discussion not later than October 5. Final versions of all proposals must be submitted by November 1. The Secretary shall distribute ballots to each Committee member as soon as possible thereafter, either electronically or by land mail. The deadline for Board members to vote on the proposals is January 1. Amendments to rules and regulations are passed if two-thirds of the submitted ballots are in favor."

CHAPTER IV: Event Requirements/Section B

B. Notification

There must be a premium for each meet that includes the dates, times, Location, entry fees, how to enter and track distance if not 200 yards. A copy of the premium must be submitted to the Webmaster at least 30 days prior to the meet dates so it can be uploaded to the CWA website.

2. State in exact words what your proposed revision, deletion or addition is and where it would fit into existing wording.

CHAPTER IV: Event Requirements/Section B

B. Notification

An informational premium must be submitted at the same time as the meet schedule request. The premium must include the dates, times, location, entry fees, how to enter and track distance if not 200 yards. If the conformation judges are known, that information must be included in the premium. If it is not known, then the judge information should say that judges are pending. Judges should be added to the premium as soon as they are selected, and the updated premium supplied to the President and the Webmaster.

Additional information is highly desirable, including but not limited to local hotel/camping information, local emergency veterinarian contacts, and/or anything else that participants would find valuable to know.

3. State the justification or rationale for this proposed change (i.e. how it will improve or enhance the existing rule).

This change makes a rule out of what is current practice. There is no reason that this information cannot be provided at the same time as the request.
